What is Kudzu

From "The American Heritage Dictionary":

Kudzu (kood'zoo) n. A vine, Pueraria lobata, native to Japan, having compound leaves and clusters of reddish purple flowers and grown for fodder and foliage.

Kudzu was brought to the US in 1876 during an exposition in Philadelphia for a Japanese garden exhibit. It hasn't stopped growing since.

Planting

Throw the seeds and run. Very Fast.

Kudzu tends to not need anything to help it grow, but it is sometimes a good idea to shout "**Incoming!**" before planting.
